## Tuition and Fee Schedule 2025-2026

- Plan A: All tuition and fees paid in full by June 1, 2025.
- Plan B: The full tuition amount is divided into 2 semester payments. One-half of the full year's tuition is due by June 1, 2025. The second half of the tuition is due by January 1, 2026.
- Plan C: The full tuition amount is divided into 10 monthly installments with the first payment due by June 1, 2025, and the last payment due on March 1, 2026.
- Plan D: The full tuition amount is divided into 12 monthly installments with the first payment due by June 1, 2025, and the last payment due on May 1, 2026.

Required Fees (Non-Refundable)		
Supply Fee	\$100	Covers classroom consumables assigned to your students (crayons, pencils, paint, scissors, special activity projects, etc) Billed once in August.
Technology Fee	K-5: \$100	Covers device lease, insurance, software, enhanced internet + wi-fi infrastructure upgrade and maintenance, on-campus troubleshooting support Billed in 10 monthly installments (Aug – May).
	6-12: \$250	
Graduation Fee (Kindergarten & HS)	\$100	Covers regalia, diploma, and ceremony supplies. Billed in March.
Athletic Fee	\$100	All students participating in sports, whether it be one sport or multiple sports (in any grade) will be required to pay an athletic fee along with any uniform cost.
Annual Fund	*TBD	Rather than institute a huge increase in tuition to cover this deficit, SCA is implementing an Annual Fund in an effort to raise the remaining 10% of funds needed. The goal is to receive enough funds to cover all of the school's expenses; however, if there is a deficit, <b><u>it will be split equally among each student and must be paid in full by May 31, 2026.</u></b> SCA will update the student body periodically throughout the year of the status of the Annual Fund Drive so that families can prepare for any financial obligation that may be necessary.

\* For the 25/26 school year, tuition is projected to cover 77% of our anticipated expenses so the remaining expenses must be covered by donations and fundraisers. Donations and fundraisers have historically covered 13% of the school's expenses which leaves a deficit of 10%.
