- Plan A: All tuition and fees paid in full by June 1, 2026.
- Plan B: The full tuition amount is divided into 2 semester payments. One-half of the full year's tuition is due by June 1, 2026. The second half of the tuition is due by January 1, 2027.
- Plan C: The full tuition amount is divided into 10 monthly installments with the first payment due by June 1, 2026, and the last payment due on March 1, 2027.
- Plan D: The full tuition amount is divided into 12 monthly installments with the first payment due by June 1, 2026, and the last payment due on May 1, 2027.

Required Fees (Non-Refundable)		
Supply Fee	\$200	Covers classroom consumables assigned to your students (crayons, pencils, paint, scissors, special activity projects, etc) Billed once in August.
Technology Fee	K-5: \$100	Covers device lease, insurance, software, enhanced internet + wi-fi infrastructure upgrade and maintenance, on-campus troubleshooting support Billed in 10 monthly installments (Aug – May).
	6-12: \$250	
Graduation Fee (Kindergarten & HS)	\$100	Covers regalia, diploma, and ceremony supplies. Billed in March.
Athletic Fee	\$100 +\$50	The athletic fee is \$100 for each student's first sport. Each additional sport is \$50. Students are also responsible for the cost of any required uniforms and/or equipment.
Annual Fund	\$1500	To help keep tuition affordable, each family is required to raise or contribute \$1,500 through the <i>14 Days for SCA</i> event to support the school's Annual Fund. This fund bridges the gap between tuition and the full cost of education, supporting technology, facilities, and Christian programs. Any unmet balance will be charged through FACTS. *While fundraising efforts, including the Annual Fund, SCA Gala, and Fun Run, are intended to sustain school operations, any remaining budget deficit may require an equal per-student payment by May 31, 2027. SCA will communicate early and clearly regarding all fundraising initiatives and any additional financial obligations.
